Entry Rules

- To bring us all some festive cheer, the theme must be based around Christmas, this could be a snow scene, a portrait of Father Christmas, a colourful collage, a present, a bauble, a Christmas tree, a reindeer, an elf or anything else you can imagine.
- Any media can be used such as paint, oil pastels, pencils, pens, tissue paper, felt, wool or even sweet wrappers and of course as much glitter as you like!
- All entries must be submitted via Class Dojo and not be brought into school so we would like you to display the art at home and enjoy it throughout the festive season!

Photographing the work

- Taken too far away
- Not straight and some of the paper not visible
- Can see background
- Shadow from holding camera
- Poor lighting so colours are not vivid enough
- Paper not laid out flat



- Taken close up
- Screenshotted and cropped to create straight edges
- No background visible
- No shadow
- Bright lighting so colours are vivid Paper laid out flat
