Keeping children safe at the end of the school day

Collecting children at the end of the day

The end of the school day (3.30pm) is always a busy time and we are observing that Alder Street is becoming quite congested at these times.

From Wednesday 6th October, our Year 3 children (class 7 and class 8) will be dismissed from school from the lower external doors (further down Alder Street). This is the exit they used last year when they were in year 2.

Parents should line up and wait at the relevant points to collect children in an organised and orderly way.

Children will be handed over to the parents and are requested to leave the school site promptly.

We will continue to review the situation at the end of the school day and if needed we will make further changes to ensure children are dismissed safely and efficiently.

Parking around the school site

There is limited parking on and around the school site. Where possible, we would encourage our parents to walk to and from school to avoid traffic congestion around school.

If you do need to bring your car to school, could we share these reminders :

- Do not park on the zig-zag lines outside school. This is dangerous and will be reported to the police.
- Always drive with extreme caution, children are likely to be crossing the roads around school.
- Please do not exceed 10mph in the vicinity of school.
- Please do not make u-turns or similar manoeuvres on either Alder Street or Oak Street
- When parking your car, be mindful of our neighbours.
