The Brush Time Tales competition

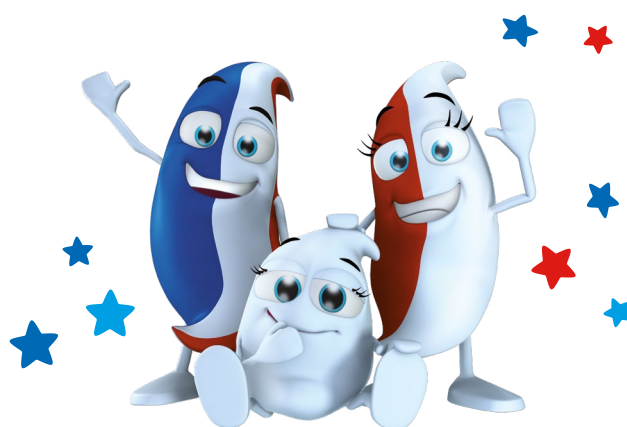

Top Tips for Good Oral Health

1. Brush twice a day for two minutes.
2. Use only a pea-sized amount of fluoride toothpaste.
3. When brushing, use small, circular movements; covering every side of the tooth and the gum line.
4. Don't rinse with water after brushing, just spit the toothpaste out.
5. Cut down on sugary and acidic food and drinks, and try to only have them at mealtimes.
