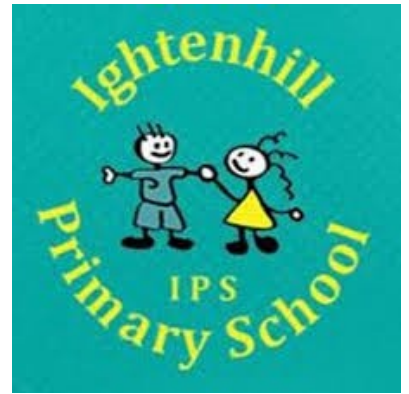

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Reading

Clothing

Please ensure that your child has their name in all their jumpers/cardigans and coats. This will make it easier for your child to get them back if they become misplaced.

Please read with your child at least three times a week and make a record of their reading in their Reading Record Books. Books should be brought into school daily and they will be changed every Monday. If you feel that your child needs them changed in-between, please ask.

Water Bottles

Some children have not returned their water bottles. Please ensure that your child has a water bottle in school so that they can have water throughout the day.



If your child has a reading sheet, please encourage them to read as often as possible. New reading sheets will be given weekly.



P.E.

Reception P.E. is on a Thursday afternoon. Please can children come into school wearing their P.E. kit on a Thursday. They will wear them for the full day. The children will need to wear their yellow P.E. top with their school jumper or cardigan, black shorts or jogging pants and their black P.E. pumps or trainers. This will continue as they move into Year 1, although the day will change.

Maths

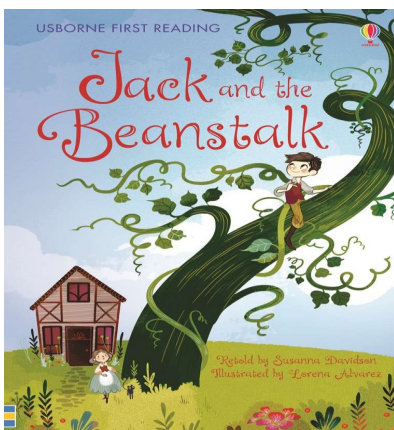


In maths this half term, we will be focusing on numbers up to 20 and beyond. We will be learning:

- addition and subtraction
- how to make numbers in different ways
- to order numbers on a number line
- to match numeral to quantity

Topic

Our topic this half term is 'Spring and Growing'. During this topic, we will be focusing on the stories 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'. We will be having different literacy lessons around these stories and doing lots of different crafts and activities. This week our caterpillars have arrived and the children were very excited! We will be watching them grow into butterflies and releasing them into the wild when they are ready. We will also be doing lots of work about the butterfly life cycle. Alongside this we will be planting sunflowers and learning how they grow. We will update you regularly on Classdojo so please continue to check them often.
