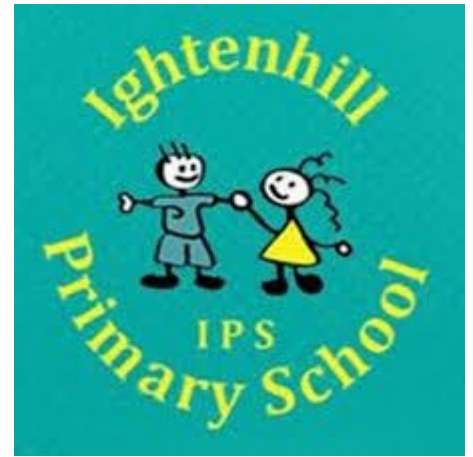
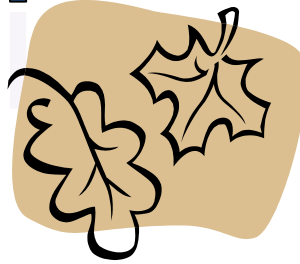

On a Monday we have a discrete science lesson. Each week we carry out a different experiment. During this time the children get to explore, predict and summarise what we have done.

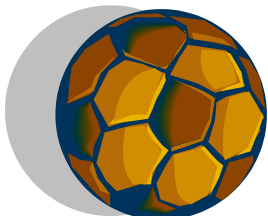


Water Bottles

Maths

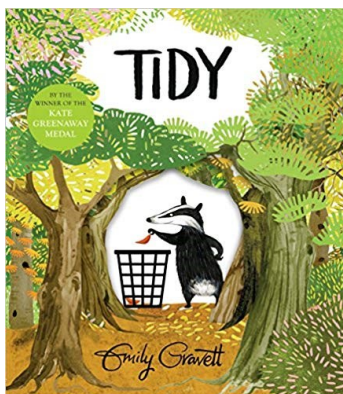


In maths this half term, we will be continuing to focus on numbers up to 20. We will be learning:

- how to count with objects
- what the numeral looks like
- addition and subtraction up to 20
- one more and one less
- 2D shapes
