English

We will spend our time reading quality texts, practising our comprehension skills and exploring key questions. We will also read poetry and non-fiction. During the half term, we will learn how to apply different grammar skills to write responses to our reading.

Spellings will be sent home weekly.

Mathematics

Children will be taught in groups by Mrs Baron, Mrs Pearson and Mrs Dunderdale.

Fractions, decimals and percentages will be the focus for this half term.

Maths homework will be sent where necessary but it essential that children know their times tables off by heart. For children who can recall them in any order at speed, they need to learn related division facts.
