le la les These small words are **determiners** . They mean **the** .

le is used before a **masculine** noun eg. le pain

la is used before a **feminine** noun eg. la pizza

les is used before a **plural** noun eg. les frites

In French, to say what you like or dislike, you use **le, la or les** before the noun.

Eg. J'aime la pizza = I like pizza

Je déteste les pommes = I hate apples

To say **some** :

Use **du** before a masculine noun eg. du chocolat = some chocolate

Use **de la** before a feminine noun eg. de la pizza = some pizza

Use **des** before a plural noun eg. des frites = some chips
