Adjectives

In French, an adjective normally comes after the noun.

Eg. un pantalon noir - black trousers

We add an 'e' if the noun is feminine.

Eg. Une jupe noire - a black skirt

We add an 's' if it is a plural noun.

Eg. des chaussures noires - black shoes

		To say some : Use du before a masculine noun eg. du chocolat = some chocolate Use de la before a feminine noun eg. de la pizza = some pizza Use des before a plural noun eg. des frites = some chips
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
