2. Look at the paragraph beginning: *“What about a...”* to the paragraph ending: *... she suggested instead.*
Why did Jess scrunch up her face?
3. Look at the paragraph beginning: *Before her fingers...*
Find and **copy** two phrases that suggest the last wish was particularly powerful.
4. Look at the paragraph beginning: *Before her fingers...*
How do you know that Jess didn't need to flap her arms or run at speed to take off and fly?
5. If the twins could have gone back in time, do you think they would have used their wishes differently?
Explain your answer using evidence from the story.
