- X3 STRAIGHT OBJECTS (RULERS/CUTLERY/ROLLING PIN)
- X5 LONG SOFT ITEMS (SCARVES/TIGHTS/LONG SOCKS)
- 6-8 TEDDY BEARS/TOYS
- DEVICE TO TAKE PHOTOS (PHONE/I-PAD)

FUNNY FACES

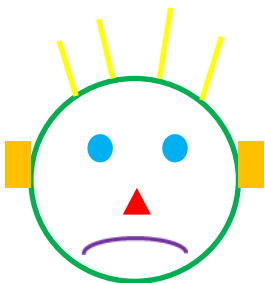
- Create a large circle with socks as the outline of a face
- Place items indicated in the key in a space away from the circle (face)
- Look at the map of the funny face , can you place the items in the right place to create the picture?
- Take one item at a time and place on the face (eg: ear/eye) , return and get the next one. Keep going until all the items have been put in the correct place and your face looks like the picture (get a grown up to check you have got it right!)
- Think of different ways of moving as you do it (hop/run/jump/skip)

Easy- Get an adult to tell you which item to collect

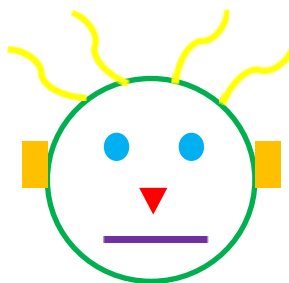
Harder - Can you put some obstacles in the way when you are running?

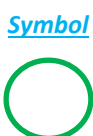

PICTURE HUNT

- Mum's/Dad's/Guardians place some Teddy bears around your home (need to be visible)
- Then take a photo of each teddy bear (see below for example)
- Can child find each teddy bear from looking at the picture (one at a time) and bring back to the adult as quickly as possible
- Children: Look at the feature near the teddy, Do you recognize it ? What is it? Where is it?
- Harder Challenge: Can the child find the teddy without a picture? With just a verbal instruction (Eg. 'The teddy is upstairs, next to something blue')
